

Statistically speaking-Contributions to **DRYING R&D**

Professor Mujumdar's contributions to initiating and developing Drying R&D on a global scale:

The following applies exclusively to Professor Mujumdar's contributions to drying in terms of teaching, research and service to worldwide academic and industrial communities. The statistics provided exclude his contributions to heat and mass transfer research in non-drying areas, which are also substantial.

- Initiated IDS series in 1978 and actively organized or chaired 16 IDS meetings in 4 continents; over 4000 papers presented
- Founded or help found several regional drying conference series such as IADC,ADC,NDC and actively helped in organization of these meetings
- Presented over 20 Plenary, 30 keynote lectures at various international and national conferences
- Presented over 100 technical papers on drying at IDSs
- Lectured in 40+ countries including lectures in workshops and short courses
- Advised 50+ companies internationally on drying-related problems
- Advised over 20 PhD and 15+ postdoctoral researchers in Canada, Singapore, China, India etc in **DRYING**
- Edited over 100 issues of Drying Technology-An International Journal since 1982 and also contributed 100+ research papers and 40+ editorials to this journal
- Presented seminars in over 150 universities, industrial and government R&D centres
- Edited 50+ books, authored one book and co-authored one book on drying
- Authored over 70 book chapters
- Editor of the Bible of Drying: Handbook of Industrial Drying ,now in third edition with 53 chapters- 23 authored/co-authored by Prof. Mujumdar
- Published 10 + papers in French, German, Czech and Chinese journals
- Books translated into Chinese, French, Hungarian, Indonesian, Thai etc
- Author of chapters in Kirk & Othmer Encyclopaedia of Chemical Technology and 5 other handbooks
- Editor-in-Chief of Drying Technology since 1987- published over 2200 refereed papers under his editorship
